
River Bank Management *Revetments*



Erosion, sometimes due to over grazing, can cause an undercut. The river can deposit tonnes of sediment from the site of erosion onto the river bed causing pollution.

Revetments are created to stabilise river banks and reduce erosion. You can either use living materials like willow hurdles or young trees, or you can use rocks and boulders to stabilise points of erosion.
